- **Air-O-Matic Cedar Mulch** - perfect for nearly any application. It's scent is detested by most insects so it adds an extra level of insect protection.
- **Native Hardwood Mulch** - comes from native hardwoods. Resists weathering and remains in place in the heaviest rains.

All three of our mulches when properly applied cut down on evaporation to help keep a constant moisture level so you have to water less. Remember that summer drought can cause soil to shrink and crack causing foundation damage. All of our mulches allow good water penetration unlike other mulches that have a tendency to clump and prevent the water from passing through to the soil where it is needed.
